Today we will be going over the whole process of harvesting pet milk in infema! it's important that we start our journey with a fresh pet, so we can cover as much as we can!



The pets picked to serve in milk farms are those who were not bought at the market but have too little regeneration powers to serve as public relief pets. Farm pets, as they're also called, don't have to endure a lot of physical harm so this works out perfectly.

Before they even arrive, their arms and legs are amputated, the wound sealed with an alloy of iron (to stop regeneration) and gold (to act as a demon mana conduit). All metals used in pet care are usually made using the combination of these two, making them very versatile.

With their optical nerves burned off and their eardrums busted, they can also neither see nor hear anything. This might sound cruel, but it greatly reduces their stress levels in the first years of service.



Statistically speaking, leaving their senses intact would be way harsher on them.

Moving on, once they are placed at their posts, their vulva is spread out using chains attached by piercings. Those are all made using the aforementioned materials.

This part is done once both the inner and the outer labia are spread apart.



This is done to facilitate access to a pet's reproductive organs. Some farms use an alternative method of cutting the extra skin off and sealing it with the proper alloy but it's a controversial method, as it may interfere with some other important steps down the line.

A farm pet's collar, by default, completely shuts off any (voluntary) movement below the neck. the spike. Although they still get to keep their vocal chords, their ability to speak is also taken.



This is possible due to the fact that it's directly connected to their spinal cord, making controlling these types of things relatively easy for any demon who knows even just the very basics of mana manipulation.

This is done to make sure the pet won't thrash around and interfere with the procedures too much.

Due to this, the pet is kept in position by the chains holding their limbs up. Without those, they would just go limp and working with them would be way too troublesome.


The next step is to chain the tip of their clitoris to the ring on their necks, pulling as taut as possible. The goal is to fully expose the underside.

A set of two very small vibrators is attached to the base. They will provide the pet with constant stimuli and will only be removed for routine cleaning.



It's important to note that the collar is also set to completely block a pet's capacity to reach orgasm. Studies show that, while genital stimuli is beneficial to a pet's health and behavior, orgasming can actually undo all those benefits, or even worse. that's why all farm pets are required by law to have this configuration.


The next step is to set those brushes on either side. They are equipped with thick, rubbery bristles that move randomly on their own.



Centuries of pet farming has shown that pets make more milk if they're kept happy and the quickest way to make a pet happy is to provide constant, strong stimulation! Once the brush and the vibrators are properly installed, it won't take long before the pet reaches a stage of complete and total bliss.

We all know pets are born to serve as pets, obviously. but due to being raised with regular angels for the first 20 years of their lives, they might start thinking that they too are people, which is evidently untrue. otherwise, they would not have been picked to be pets at all.

It may take weeks or months, but all pets eventually get there. It all depends on how resistant they seem to be against accepting their roles, but they all are able to do so sooner rather than later.



A tube is then inserted into their rectum. a pet's digestive system no longer works like that of regular demons and angels, the only "food" they get is a nutritive gel that goes right into their intestines for quick absorption.

This means they produce no solid waste. The tube is just a way to automate the feeding process.

This wraps up the initial preparations! The next step is to get them pregnant with their first litter.



It's important to make sure that farm pets only ever get impregnated with angels, not demons. their fetuses are smaller, thus making delivery easier, and they can be sent down south to be raised by angel families. That rule is part of the "pet system treaty".

After a speculum is inserted, we can have a better view of their cervixes. Then, a "pipe" in the shape roughly similar to a demon's penis is inserted inside of them, a tube coming out of it and going straight into the pet's womb.



It's important that the spikes are properly attached to the pet's vaginal canal, fully sealing it. This seal is supposed to do the job a knot would do during natural intercourse and insemination.



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This is important because a pet will only ovulate once their womb is completely full. If the seal is not done properly, you run the risk of running the whole process!



Thankfully, pet angels are extremely fertile, the probability of a successful pregnancy after just one try is around 98% percent!

Because they're not yet used to the fullness, it's not unusual for a pet to leak piss for the first time during this step.



A pet is supposed to just let their liquid waste flow out as needed, as a caretaker will clean any messes, but some of them take a while to get used to this. Those who end up leaking during their first insemination seem to have an easier time adapting, so it's usually viewed as a good sign.

Please be aware that there's a very big difference between leakage and the results of a pet's arousal.




In this case, the seal has been done properly, so any contents that seem to be "leaking" are just the fluids a pet makes when feeling pleasure. Not only is this perfectly normal but it's also a sign the pet is healthy.

The difference between the two is that a pet's fluid is fully transparent, semen is mostly white. if the liquid coming out looks any shade of white, there's a possibility a leakage might have happened.

The seal will remain for at least a couple of hours, to make sure impregnation is successful.

In the meantime, we can finally start on the milking part of the process!



Two suction cups will be attached to each of the pet's nipples. They are equipped with soft brushes inside that also provide the pet with extra stimulation, although their actual purpose is to help with nipple development.

Of course, at this point the pet is not lactating yet, but the sooner you hook them up to a machine, the sooner they will start.

After three full hours have passed, the seal is finally removed.

Semen will flow out of the pet very quickly, so the person doing it must always be wearing proper gear.

Some pets groan and complain, but as you can see, this one barely even seems to notice. It seems he has grown used to its new life very fast!

After just a few weeks of this, the pet's body will have gone through a lot of changes. For pets that already had breasts, the increase in size will be noticeable but small, but for those who didn't, the changes tend to be a bit harsher. At this point, they are making around 20 liters of milk a day!



Their bellies will also have grown a considerable amount. By the time they reach this state, most of them have already stopped wincing in pain or crying out every time they are touched by handlers, some, like the one we are following, are already so used to their role that they even smile then touch.

Handlers tend to get especially attached to these, usually going out of their way to rub their hair or bellies, which they seem to particularly like.



The suction cups are taken out daily for cleaning. As you can see, this pet's nipples have also grown quite a lot in length! they are also very sensitive, this one seems to really like when they are played with.

After around 40 weeks, the pet will be ready to give birth to their first litter! At this stage they usually will have reached their maximum capacity for daily milk production, which should average at around 35 liters per day.



Their breasts, no matter how big or small they might have been before coming to the farm, are now huge, some of them being as big as the pet's head. The biggest growth spurt of their breasts now over, although they never really stop growing. The changes are just way more gradual.

Once the time for delivery finally comes, a thick liquid comes out of them as their cervixes open up to make passage for the egg.

Since it's their first time, the pet might be scared of the sudden pain and discomfort, so it's not unusual for a handler or caretaker to stay next to them to try and soothe them a bit.



Remember, stress is the main thing we want to avoid when dealing with milk pets, as it greatly affects the quality and quantity of their product!

A basket is then placed right under the pet's birth canal.

Once their offspring is born, the egg they're in will safely land in there. They may be a bit slippery and, since the pet's are kept in a relatively tall structure, it's safer than having someone try and grab them



Studies show that, during birth, excess stimuli is more harmful than beneficial to their stress levels, which is why both the brushes and vibrators are temporarily taken off of them.

If necessary, a handler might use their hands to provide soft stimuli, but it's up to their discretion.




Even after the egg becomes visible and starts to squeeze through the pet's opening, it will still be a while before their labor is over. Although angel eggs are much smaller than a demon's, they are still not easy for a pet, especially an inexperienced one, to deliver.



It's not uncommon for a pet to scream when the thicker part of the egg is passing through. This is one of the reasons why it's important to take away a milk pet's hearing, otherwise, they'd all get stressed every time one gave birth.



**After a couple of hours, this one is finally done delivering its first egg!
It is a bit tired, so it will be given a full day of rest before stimuli is
added back and it is impregnated again.**



**This will be the routine of any farm pet until they can finally retire
which will only happen after their last eggs are used and they can no
longer be pregnant.**

**Milk that comes from non-pregnant pets is too low-quality to sell, so
they're not used anymore.**

Some handlers will sometimes "adopt" them if it's a pet they particularly like, taking care of them for the very few years they still have left, but most will just get euthanized.

Don't feel bad for them though, they will have spent their whole lives happily doing what they were born to do!

At their core, a pet's purpose is to serve society, so once they're no longer useful, it's only natural that they would be disposed of.

Humanely, of course, we care deeply about them! our country depends on their hard work for it's success, after all!

Anyway, this is how the pet we followed through this pamphlet looks like today!

It has already delivered over 30 eggs and has an amazing production of almost 40 liters of milk a day!

See just how happy he looks? That's how the pets in our form all look! so don't worry about them, they're the happiest they could ever be!
